A 4-H County Award is the highest honor bestowed on a Michigan 4-H member at the County level. 4-H County Award winners become part of an elite group of 4-H youth who have demonstrated the highest level of excellence in learning, leadership, and service. The program recognizes 4-H members in all project areas ages 11 -19.

The deadline is October 1. The finished portfolio should represent the 4-H member's best work. 4-H leaders and 4-H county staff are great resources to provide feedback during the application process. Applications are then carefully reviewed by a selection committee. All County Award participants will be recognized formally at the Macomb County 2018 Awards Event. The event will be held November 4th, 2018, 2 pm at the Clinton office, 21885 Dunham Road, Clinton Township.
